# School Policy Reminders

- For your child to be eligible to attend school, you must turn in updated health forms by the last forms expiration date. We must also have a copy of your child's birth certificate.
- Tuition payments are due on the first of the month, and payments are late on the tenth day of the month. No statement will be send unless money was previously owed.
- When bringing medication to school, please remember that it must be in the original container indicating your child's name, type and date of prescribed medication. This must be given to the teacher so it can be stored properly. Paperwork must be completed for medication to be dispensed. **DO NOT LEAVE MEDICATION IN YOUR CHILD'S LUNCHBOX OR CUBBY.**
- **PLEASE DO NOT PARK IN THE STAFF PARKING LOT.** Teachers often carry heavy loads and rely on your consideration.
- Preschool classrooms are open for students at 8:50 a.m. If you need to drop off your child earlier then please take them to early arrival, in Kathy Birkof's room.
- Preschool parents, remember to sign in and out on the class sheet of After School Care Sign-Out Sheets. This is an extra measure to protect your children If you are picking up your children early, and they are scheduled to stay for an afternoon activity (aftercare, ballet, etc.), please let the teacher on the playground know that you are leaving with your child and they will not be staying for their after school activity.
- For your child's lunch box, please include a spoon if needed. We have limited plastic utensils to hand out. Also, please resist the urge to put a candy and chocolate in your child's lunch. Candy is sweet, but good health is sweeter! **REMEMBER WE ARE A NUT-FREE SCHOOL!**
- 3 year olds not potty trained will be charged an additional fee per month.
- Elementary families, please remember that you are required to complete 20 volunteer hours per year.
